The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs Osowski and Newport to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PL321...

ALLEGATION:

The complainant, Corey HUDSON, alleges that two known Milwaukee police officers did strike him in the face causing pain and injury.

INVESTIGATION:

This complaint was investigated by Det. Glenn ZIRGIBEL. A review of the offense reports indicate that P.O. Dean NEWPORT and P.O. Jon OSOWSKI did arrest Corey HUDSON for Obstructing an Officer in addition to POCS (marijuana) and Loitering - Drug Activity as well as Operating After Revocation. The reports indicate there was a brief foot chase when an FI attempt was made in the area of the 2800 block of W. Concordia Avenue. During the foot chase P.O. OSOWSKI fell injuring his right hand, right wrist, right elbow and right knee. P.O. NEWPORT did continue to pursue this subject and was able to apprehend him in the area 3200 N. 28th Street.
