


ELA FORWARD EXAM


MATH FORWARD EXAM


ELEMENTARY ACADEMIC GROWTH



9TH & 10TH PREACT-SECURE EXAM



HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMIC GROWTH




11TH GRADE ACT AVERAGE SCORE




2024 CLASS GRADUATION RATES






