File #021624 is a resolution to approving a Three-Year Harbor Statement of Intentions for the Port of Milwaukee.

### **BACKGROUND**

- 1. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT), in accord with state statute, requires a statement of project intentions from local units of government intending to apply for Federal and/or State aid for harbor-related work of benefit to commercial transportation within the next three years.
- 2. The Three-Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions is used by the WISDOT for planning purposes only and is not an application for Federal and/or State aid.
- 3. The Board of Harbor Commissioners approved the Three-Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions at the meeting of February 7, 2003.
- 4. In order to be eligible for future grants under WISDOT Harbor Assistance Program, an annual update of the Port's Three Year Statement of Intentions is required to be adopted by the Common Council and submitted to the State by April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

#### **DISCUSSION**

1. The Three-Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions for 2003 – 2006 describes proposed improvements. The proposed future projects are as follows:
