There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines: Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Attached are two videos captured prior to the physical assault. These recordings appear to show the initiation of the altercation.

Based on current information, the individuals present include _____; the suspect known as _____); and an unidentified male accompanying _____. It is believed that this unidentified individual may have been acting as security for Dragon's Place; however, they cannot be confirmed as such, as he was not wearing any form of identifiable uniform or markings.

The females visible in the video are with _____ and are considered parties associated with _____

Under Wisconsin law, security personnel are generally required to be clearly identifiable while performing their duties. Specifically, Wisconsin Statute 440.26 (private security personnel regulation) requires that private security persons display or carry proper identification and, in many cases, wear attire that clearly distinguishes them as security while on duty. The individual(s) in question does not appear to meet these standards based on the video evidence.

Good afternoon Asia,

Thanks for reaching out—we have received your objection to the licenses and it has been added to their record. As a note, objections are taken into consideration at the time of renewal of their license each year, so if they were to expire in September for example, this would remain on file until about a month or 2 before the expiration when they would then take the renewal up at a Committee hearing because of your objection on file.

This actually just came up for renewal though as their licenses are up in June, so the objection has been added and will now trigger a Licenses Committee hearing to be required. This hearing would be for any renewed license specifically, so if they were to be “non renewed” or suspended at that hearing, they would legally be able to continue operating until their current licenses expire in June.

If you are looking for a more immediate action on their license, you would need to file a revocation complaint specifically. I’ve attached a flyer that outlines how to submit the revocation complaint (left hand side of the 2nd page) as well as what happens during a revocation complaint specifically (right hand side of the 2nd page). This would be a special hearing just for this application and could result in suspension, revocation, or no action taken against the license.

Dear Members of the Bar Licensing Committee,

I am writing to formally report a critical and life-threatening incident involving [REDACTED] that occurred in the early morning hours of April 5, 2026, in connection with Dragons Place, located at 7200 W. Fond du Lac Avenue in Milwaukee.

To clarify the sequence of events, a **minor incident occurred while [REDACTED] was initially leaving the bar** with [REDACTED] girlfriend and others. As [REDACTED] attempted to hold the door open for [REDACTED] girlfriend and a friend, an individual identified by the nickname "[REDACTED]" who is visible in surveillance footage wearing a black and white striped Adidas outfit, attempted to close the door. This led to a brief verbal exchange.

In an effort to de-escalate the situation, [REDACTED] introduced [REDACTED] and extended [REDACTED] hand in a non-threatening manner. The individual known as [REDACTED] responded by slapping [REDACTED] hand away, and a verbal disagreement followed, as seen in available video recordings. At that point, [REDACTED] left the establishment.

Approximately an hour or more later, [REDACTED] was **called back to the bar by individuals believed to be security associated with the establishment.** My [REDACTED] is a frequent patron of Dragons Place and regularly visits the bar. Based on this familiarity, it is reasonable to believe that [REDACTED] felt safe returning when contacted by individuals [REDACTED] believed were responsible for maintaining safety and order.

Upon returning, when [REDACTED] pulled [REDACTED] vehicle to the front of Dragons Place, [REDACTED] was ambushed by these individuals. The situation immediately escalated into a **violent and brutal assault.** It is alleged that an individual wearing a tan outfit is believed to be security personnel for the establishment. He was present and actively involved in the attack on [REDACTED]. This same individual is seen on video returning inside the establishment shortly after 2:00 a.m., while [REDACTED] was left severely injured in the middle of West Fond du Lac Avenue.

Even more concerning, [REDACTED] was **abandoned without aid** following the assault. No staff or security intervened to stop the attack, de-escalate the situation, or provide medical assistance. Instead, [REDACTED] was left lying in the street, and the same individuals proceeded to rob [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] personal belongings from [REDACTED] vehicle.

As a direct result of this incident, [REDACTED] is currently in a medically induced coma, suffering from severe head trauma, brain swelling, and internal bleeding of [REDACTED] brain. [REDACTED] injuries are life-threatening and have had a devastating impact on [REDACTED] future ability to function as [REDACTED] did prior to this incident remains unknown. Due to the severity of [REDACTED] medical condition, it is unclear at this time whether [REDACTED] will experience memory loss, regain the ability to walk, or what [REDACTED] cognitive abilities will be moving forward.

This incident raises serious concerns regarding the conduct, oversight, and responsibility of the owner and employees of Dragons Place, including but not limited to:

- Calling a patron back to the establishment after a prior conflict and placing him in a dangerous situation
- Failure to maintain a safe and secure environment for patrons
- Failure of security personnel to be clearly identifiable and act appropriately
- Alleged participation of security staff in a violent assault

- Failure to intervene or de-escalate a preventable situation
- Failure to render aid to a critically injured individual
- Allowing violent criminal activity, including assault and robbery, to occur on or immediately adjacent to the premises

Given the severity of this incident and the apparent negligence and misconduct involved, I respectfully request that the Bar Licensing Committee conduct a **full and immediate investigation** into Dragons Place. The facts strongly suggest a failure to uphold the responsibilities required to operate a licensed establishment and raise significant concerns about public safety.

I further urge the Committee to consider appropriate disciplinary action, including the **revocation of the establishment's license**.

This matter is urgent and involves severe, life-threatening injuries. We ask for your immediate attention to ensure accountability and to prevent further harm to others in the community.

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/09/24 at 12:21a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired at 7200 W. Fond du Lac Ave. Investigation revealed security escorted two subjects outside due to an altercation. The subjects walked to the parking lot area, when the agent and security heard a gunshot from that area. The agent then called the police. The agent stated they have video surveillance, however, was not able to pull up the video due to technical difficulties with the app on their phone.

2. On 09/28/24 at 6:08p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Traffic Hazard at 7200 W. Fond du Lac. Investigation revealed a car show was being hosted next to the bar, however, a Facebook flyer did list the name and address of the bar, as well as drink specials. Officers noted an abundance of vehicles parked all around the location, as well as a tent selling food, and large speakers playing music. The agent stated it was not their event, but agreed to put their address on the flyer, due to the car show being hosted next door. The agent was advised in the future to obtain a permit to host a special event. Officers advised citizens to move their vehicles, and by 8p.m., the lot was empty.

3. On 10/26/24 at 9:13p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 7200 W. Fond du Lac. No violations were found.

4. On 03/29/25 at 12:52a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Noise Nuisance. Officers encountered a subject playing loud music from their motorcycle, requested they turn it down, to which they complied.
5. On 04/17/25 at 12:11a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. Investigation revealed several subjects were fighting inside the establishment due to seating arrangements. The business was cooperative and requested all parties leave the establishment.
6. On 05/18/25 at 9:53p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. The victim refused to speak to officers and left the scene. The business was cooperative.
7. On 12/04/25 at 12:27a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Shots Fired. The manager stated a family was causing a disturbance and were asked to leave, when a small fight took place outside. The manager stated they did not hear any shots fired and everyone had already left.
8. On 04/05/26 at 2:22a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. Investigation revealed the victim and suspect were in a verbal argument, which eventually turned physical, causing the victim to be knocked out. The victim was unconscious, had a pulse, but not breathing. Officers observed major swelling and bleeding to the face. The victim was transported to a hospital where officers were informed they would survive, however, would likely suffer long term cognitive delays. Follow up was conducted with the Agent who provided video surveillance of the incident.

Upon arrival, while attempting to call the unknown caller back, an altercation broke out inside of the business away from officer's view. There were multiple subjects yelling and screaming at each other as officers approached. I was able to speak with the manager of the business Andre S. JAMES (M/B, 03-11-79) who stated multiple females were arguing with an older crowd of ladies inside of the tavern over some seats. JAMES stated he moved everyone around inside of the tavern and when things got out of hand, he "kicked out" multiple female subjects as well as a couple that had been arguing inside the business.

I was unable to speak to the caller who reported this incident with phone number (414) 517-2166.

The business was cooperative the investigation and just wanted all parties to leave the business. The business had 0 security officers on scene. No video surveillance footage was reviewed.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted behind the bar and they were up to date, expiring 06-19-2025. During my investigation, I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

On Sunday, April 5th, 2026, at 2:22 AM, while in full duty uniform and with an Axon body-worn camera activated and in a marked squad, P.O. Jacob BLANCO and I were dispatched to a Battery complaint call located at 7200 W Fond Du Lac Ave (Dragon's Place Bar), which is located in the city and county of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, officers observed a male, unresponsive, face down in the road in front of the listed address. The male had major swelling and bleeding to the face. The male had a pulse but did not appear to be breathing.

Milwaukee Fire Department, Med 16 and Engine 8 arrived on scene. MFD assessed and treated the patient before loading the patient into the transport van.

P.O. BLANCO was able to identify the individual with a WI driver's license found inside of a wallet on his person. The unresponsive male was identified as Allen R. LANE (B/M DOB 05/30/79).

I spoke with a security guard at the location, identified as Andre S. JAMES (B/M DOB 03/11/79) who stated LANE was at the location arguing with another male outside of the business. JAMES stated he told both men to stop arguing in front of the business as he did not want things to escalate. JAMES stated LANE got into his vehicle and left, so he went back inside of the business. JAMES stated a little time after LANE came back to the scene while the other males were still in the parking lot. JAMES stated a LANE kept arguing with the subjects from before and made gestures like he was going to pull out a firearm. JAMES stated the subjects began "tussling" and at a certain point LANE got "knocked out" and fell to the ground. JAMES stated the other male continued to kick LANE and eventually stopped then got into a vehicle and left.

JAMES stated he moved LANE to the side of the road, so he was not in the middle of the street and waited for medical to show up.

JAMES stated the cameras to the business are accessible to the manager of the business so he would get in contact with the manager for the footage if the cameras work.

Squad 7441 (P.O. Blake KASBERGER and P.O. Ricky LOZANO) responded to the scene to take pictures. 11 photos were taken at 2:45 AM.

LANE was transported to Froedtert Hospital by Med 16. Upon arrival, LANE was taken to room B in the Emergency Department. LANE was admitted at 2:59 AM and treated by Dr. Taylor SONNENVERG. LANE was still unconscious when in the hospital, so officers have been unable to speak with him about the incident.

FOLLOW-UP:

P.O. Ryan MIRONCZUK and I went to Froedtert 04/05/2026 at 9:46 PM to conduct follow-up with LANE. We were informed by his nurse, Sheila H., that LANE was intubated and sedated, so he would be unable to speak with officers. We were informed LANE had fracture to his right face/orbital, some hemorrhaging, and a hematoma. Sheila stated to officers, that LANE is expected to survive, but it is possible he may have long term cognitive delays.

CANVASS:

P.O. MIRONCZUK and I performed a canvass of the area near the Dragon's Place Bar (7200 W Fond Du Lac Ave).

- 7200 W Fond Du Lac Ave (Dragon's Place Bar): The bar was closed today (04/05/26). I observed five total cameras on the business; one located on each side of the building and two located in front.
- 7219 W Fond Du Lac Ave (Cut Loose Auto Repair): The business was closed upon arrival. I two observed cameras on the SE corner of the building.
- 7169 W Fond Du Lac Ave (Mil-City Motors): The business was closed upon arrival. I observed two cameras on the South side of the building and 3 cameras on the NE side of the building.
- 7153 W Fond Du Lac Ave (Residence): No one was home at the time of arrival; one camera was observed on the home on the East side of the home.

CALLERS INFORMATION:

Upon reviewing the list of callers for this incident, three different callers place a call for service for the altercation outside of the bar.

An individual named "Pamela" (phone # 414-722-0639) did not answer the phone on call back.

An unidentified individual, phone number 414-614-9569 did not answer the phone on call back.

An individual named "Phoenix" (414-408-4943) answered on call back but stated they were working at the moment and would prefer a call back tomorrow at approximately 6 PM. Phoenix stated they saw the male on the ground but had a Lyft passenger in the car so called and continued with their route. Phoenix did not get any recording of the incident.

On 04/06/26, follow up was conducted with the Agent to view video surveillance.

Interview of WANG:

WANG stated she is the owner of the Dragon Place Bar. WANG stated she was not present during the

incident but stated she heard about the incident from social media. WANG advised me that there was video surveillance at the establishment however the exterior cameras on the west end of the property (towards W Fond Du Lac Av). were not functional. WANG provided me video surveillance of the exterior along the north side, east (rear) and south side of the property. WANG also provided me with video surveillance of the interior of the establishment.

Video Surveillance:

WANG stated the time and date stamp were accurate. I observed multiple camera titles to include:

Exterior Video

- Rear parking (which covers the east end of the property parking lot facing southeast).
- North parking (which covers the north end of the property parking lot facing northwest).
- South parking which covers the south end of the property parking lot facing southwest).

Interior Video

- Front hallway (which covers the front vestibule of the property between the exterior front door and interior front door).
- Front pool table (which covers the entry way where the security guard acts as a doorman prior to getting to the bar)
 - Front bar (which covers the entirety of the "L" shaped main bar)

Video:

At approximately 1:24:52 am -- The two suspects identified enter the Dragon's Place Bar and are immediately searched by the security officer. The suspects and victim are observed congregating near the bar with no visible evidence of any argument or incident taken part.

At approximately 2:03:59 am -- The victim and one suspect (with the matching stripes) are walking from the west observed arguing with close proximity. There are two unknown black females standing within close proximity of the two males. While the two unknown black females are trying to get in between the arguing males, the second suspect (with the blue jeans) is observed walking from the west. Shortly, the security guard is observed walking out of the rear door of the establishment (located on the east end of the property). Both the security guard and the second suspect try to separate the victim and suspect (with the matching stripes). At one point, the suspect (with the matching stripes) pushes the security guard. At one point both the victim and suspect (with the matching stripes) shove each other and the security guard wraps his arms around the suspect's body and places him in a bear hug. While this is happening, one of the unknown females proceeds to move the victim away from the suspect (with the matching stripes). Victim is observed entering and operating a black Cadillac SUV and proceeds to drive towards the north parking lot.

At approximately 2:13:00 am -- The victim and one suspect (with the matching stripes) are observed speaking to each other civilly. Security is observed walking towards both men but everything appears

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calm between the two parties. At approximately 2:14 am -- The victim and suspect once again are in close proximity of each other's faces and appear to be arguing. The parties walk eastbound out of frame.

At approximately 2:17 am the suspect (with the matching stripes) is observed walking back into frame entering and operating a black SUV. The suspect (with the matching stripes) stop the motor vehicle as he is exiting the north end parking lot and the front end of the motor vehicle is on W Fond Du Lac Av. The suspect is observed exiting the motor vehicle and walking eastbound out of frame. At approximately 2:18 am, the suspect (with the matching stripes) was observed being pushed back to his motor vehicle by security and ultimately leaving.
