REASON FOR REQUEST:

Rupert Reilly, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle that was traveling eastbound on West Good Hope Road with its lights and siren activated. As the City vehicle approached the intersection of West Good Hope Road and North 43<sup>rd</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling northbound on North 43<sup>rd</sup> Street, failed to yield the right of way and collided with the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Reilly sustained injuries to his head, neck and back. The treating physician indicated that the back injury is permanent and that the anticipated cost of the future medical expenses would be \$800.00 per year. The claimed past medical expenses and lost wages, total \$7,909.98.
