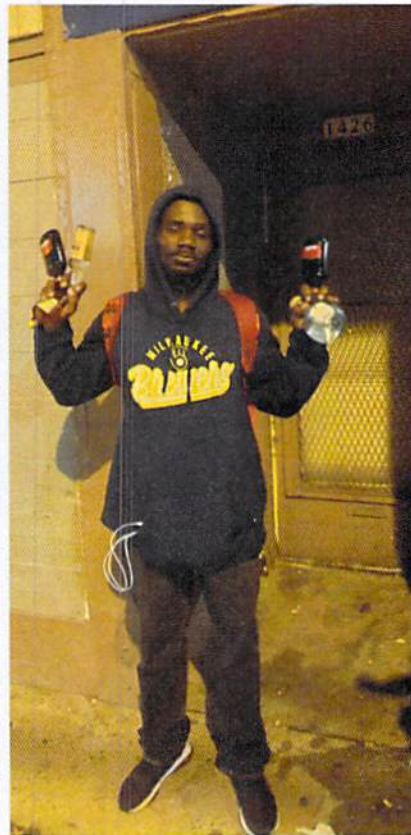


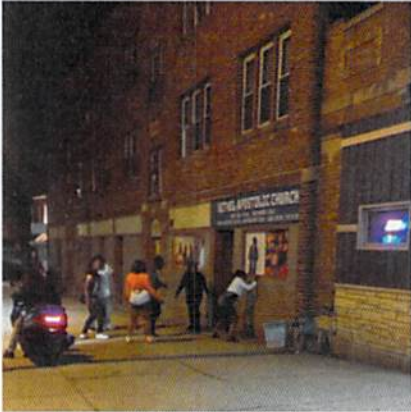
We will add signage stating, please respect the neighbors, keep the music and noise down. Every hour staff will go outside to check on loitering and make sure patrons know not to have drinks outside, and no just standing around and also cleaning up any debris. We clean up after close and before opening everyday. We will add outdoor cameras and flood lights to light up the lot next to us, which people park and hang out in. Getting no loitering signs and posting them outside the building. We would appreciate it they could put the cement blocks on the field to stop cars from parking. My security informs everyone that tries to enter the bar, if they are park in the lot, they cant enter the bar. Its already a given no entry with firearms. We have pictures of how they hang out in front of the apartment buildings next to us and up the street. They

have chairs, tables, boom boxes. I mean they have they're own party going on. But they live there. I don't have an issue with asking the police to disburse them, but I really don't want this to become something against my license. These are new neighbors that's move there, address 1430 and 1438 w. Atkinson ave, at the beginning of the summer. We have personally called 911 for a couple of neighbors who were getting into with family members around 4 separate times, and this in the afternoon while we're stocking and cleaning. I do believe with it being summertime and people not having air conditioning in their apartments, they want to hangout outside, but everybody carry guns and weapons and they get to arguing and next thing you know, they shooting. We haven't had any issues in the bar, in front of the bar. But as we all know these people just shot don't

know where they shooting they just shooting. We know there's alot that goes on all up and down Atkinson from prostitution, gang violence, drug activity, etc. It's been like that for as long as I can remember. Alot of people look to us for help from book bags for school kids, which we do every year, feeding and clothing alot of homeless in the area, this includes children that are out there trying to find something to eat. People needed to contact police when they are in trouble. We are there to help our community. This has been a family owned business for over 30 years. It's my livelihood, it's jobs for people. We all know how bad it is out here, and I mean everywhere, not just Atkinson. We will continue to do what we can to help this community better, be cooperative and helpful with the police. As you can see this gun violence is not just limited to Atkinson.







We have come in the morning to have clean these types of things. This happens while we're closed. We clean it up though.
