Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, lilegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Officers spoke to the complainant by phone, identified as Jesse Ambrowiak, (w/m 02-21-83) who stated there are many nights on the weekend when the music is emanating from the Art Bar. This particular night, the music was especially loud and the bass was turned up high enough to hear loudly at his apartment with his window closed. Investigation revealed the front door to the Art Bar was held open by a door wedge. Music was playing from turntables inside and was very loud. Officers spoke with the owner Donald Krause (w/m 08-03-60) who stated he thought the music had to be turned down by 11:00 pm due to the recent changes to the "open bar window" ordinances. Krause received a citation for Noise Nuisances.

4. On 02/08/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 722 East Burleigh Street (Art Bar). The victim, Andrew Hunter, states he was a patron at the business when he was involved in an altercation with another patron. The suspect placed Hunter in a "sleeper" choke hold around his neck. Once separated, the suspect told Hunter, "I'll find you, I know who you are now...".A third party told officers that the bartender, Zachary Matthes, knew who the suspect was. Matthes told officers he did not know the suspect, but would check his bar tab. After checking the tab, Matthes told officers the suspect was Justin Hendree, but he did not know him or have any additional information regarding him. Officers discovered where Hendree lived and made contact with him at his residence. While at his residence, Hendree's cell phone rang. Hendree told officers it was Matthes calling to warn Hendree that the police were on their way. Milwaukee police incident report #160390007 was filed regarding the battery/strangulation. While the police report indicates that Matthes was cited for Resist/Obstructing Police, the citation appears in the Milwaukee Municipal Court Query system as Disorderly Conduct.

5. On 11/27/20 at 10:48pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 722 E. Burleigh Street. No violations were found and the employee welcomed police to check in on the tavern.

6.	On 11/10/21 at 11:08pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 722 E. Burleigh Street for a battery complaint. Investigation revealed that two patrons entered the tavern and order a bee When they were asked to pay for it, they became irate and started throwing things at the bartender. The couple left the establishment before police arrival.
7.	On 01/28/23 at 1:36p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 722 E. Burleigh. Investigation revealed an intoxicated patron entered the location and was causing a disturbance. An employee noticed the level of intoxication and asked the patron to leave. The patron exited and went to the bar next door, at which time the employee called the bar and advised them not to serve the intoxicated patron. The patron then returned to the bar and was physically escorted out. Once outside a struggled ensued between the employee and the patron. The agent was notified and was cooperative and provided officers with video surveillance of the incident.

This report is written by Police Officer Luis MENDOZA, assigned to District Five, Late Power Shift.

On Wednesday, April 30th, 2025, at approximately 8:04 PM, squad 5468 (P.O. Kyle LABENSKEY and I) were dispatched to 722 E Burleigh St (ART BAR), located in the City and County of Milwaukee, for a battery complaint. My partner and I, were in full duty uniform, operating a fully marked Milwaukee Police Department squad, and equipped with Axon body worn cameras.

Upon arrival, I made contact with a bartender who verbally identified herself as Alison LECHNER (f/w, 11-9-79).

LECHNER escorted us to one of the parties involved in the fight, who spoke to P.O. LABENKSY,.

LECHNER stated a patron, which she described a black male, 5'10", medium build, early 30's, wearing a black/white flannel, and jeans, appeared to be intoxicated and bothering other patrons. LECHNER stated she was serving drinks when she heard a lot of commotion near the pool table. LECHNER stated she then observed the listed subject throw a cue ball (billiard ball) at another patron. LECHNER stated a fight broke out amongst the two. LECHNER stated the subject beat up the victim and fled on foot.

During our investigation, the victim also left the scene.

LECHNER stated the bar does have video but only the owner has access. LECHNER stated the bar never has security because the crowd is always calm.

LECHNER handed me a cellphone and stated it belonged to the suspect. P.O. LABENKSY placed in on inventory as safekeeping

LECHNER was cooperative during the entire investigation.

We were operating a fully marked City of Milwaukee Police Department squad car, vehicle 502, and were in full M.P.D. uniforms with operating Axon mobile body worn cameras during this investigation.

At approximately 10:20PM, we were dispatched to a Subject with a Weapon complaint at 722 E. Burleigh St (Art Bar) which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival we met with the caller who was verbally identified as HAASE, Donovan J., (W/M, 04/17/84)

who is an employee at Art Bar. HASSE stated an unknown male keeps coming to the location to make threats to damage property. HAASE described the subject as a black male, approximately 6'00, last seen wearing a batman sweater, riding a white bike and goes by the name of Nate. HAASE stated there was an incident that "Nate" was involved in, (REF: C2504300190), and ever since that incident Nate was banned from the bar. HAASE also stated that "Nate" would bring his own alcohol into the bar and drink his own beer. HAASE stated he just wants the subject to stop coming to Art Bar.

I spoke to a group of customers sitting outside of the Art Bar, and I identified one of them as HINES, Seamus M., (W/M, 10/28/02). HINES stated Nate did not make direct threats to harm him or any of his friends and the threats were mainly towards the Art Bar. HINES and his friends stated Nate grabbed a brick from his sweater and was making threats to damage property at the Art Bar. One of the subjects stated that Nate fled east on E. Burleigh St, then south on N. Bremen St on his bike.

HAASE was cooperative during the investigation and was given a community contact card.



The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/11/2025 at 1:00 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
