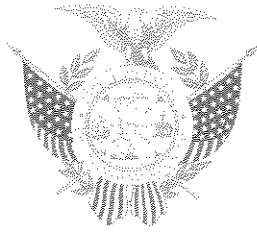

Dear Members:

Common Council File 120497 contains the following recommendations:

Nonrenewal of the public passenger vehicle driver's license of Charles E. Broughton based upon nonappearance. (Committee vote 5 – 0)

Nonrenewal of the public passenger vehicle driver's license of Michael D. Hudson based upon nonappearance. (Committee vote 5 – 0)

Renewal with a 10 day suspension for the public passenger vehicle driver's license of Ali C. Keita based upon the police report and driving record. (Committee vote 4 – 1)

Renewal with a 10 day suspension for the public passenger vehicle driver's license of Richard R. Laasiri based upon the driving record. (Committee vote 5 – 0)

Nonrenewal of the taxicab permit of Opinder Singh based upon the police report, criminal complaint, and judgment conviction. (Committee vote 4-0)

With regard to the files listed above, the Public Safety Committee held an evidentiary hearing on October 4, 2012.
