**1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):**

The purpose of the HIV Partner Services Grant is to reduce the incidence of AIDS/HIV in Milwaukee through preventive health education services, partner services and focused disease intervention activities. This grant allows the Milwaukee Health Department to provide HIV testing services in the community as well as case finding and partner services for cases AIDS/HIV.

**2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:**

This program supports the department strategic goals of:

- Reducing communicable disease

**3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):**

The HIV Partner Services Grant from the State Division of Public Health is used to support MHD program activities directed toward

- Community outreach and partnership with organizations associated with service to high risk populations (minority youth);
- Screening and testing of clients who present at the MHD Keenan Health Center for HIV; and,
- Partner services to newly diagnosed or identified cases of AIDS/HIV to provide resources and assist with notification and testing of sexual partners and or needle sharing contacts to mitigate spread of disease within the City.

Funding supports 2.0 FTE Disease Intervention Specialists to carry out HIV case management as well as 51,000 for HIV testing supplies.

**4. Results Measurement/Progress Report (Applies only to Programs):**

Key performance measures that will be tracked:

- # of new HIV cases identified in the City of Milwaukee / Milwaukee County
- % of new HIV cases interviewed within 7 days of report (goal is  $\geq$  85% or more)
- # of contacts \ associates offered services
- % of HIV cases closed within 45 days of original interview (goal is  $\geq$  85% or more)
- # of individuals tested by MHD for HIV

**5. Grant Period, Timetable and Program Phase-out Plan:**

The grant period is January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. If funding is not continued the City would need to assume funding through tax levy for these programs as it is a requirement under state statute that investigation of HIV cases be performed.
