A resolution appropriating \$100,000 from the Common Council Contingent Fund to the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund Special Purpose Account (SPA).

### **Background**

- 1. Common Council File # 030083 placed expenditure authority for the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund Special Purpose Account with the Office of the City Attorney.
- 2. The amount budgeted for the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund Special Purpose account in the 2007 budget is \$225,000.
- 3. The most recent report by the City Attorney (File # 060942) concerning expenditures from the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund SPA shows expenditures in 2007 of approximately \$200,000 through September 11, 2007.

### **Discussion**

- 1. Among other demands upon the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund SPA, two ongoing matters continue to require substantial expenditures. The firm of Gunta & Reak has been paid more than \$69,000 in the current year primarily for work and expenses related to the Jude litigation. The firm of Miller & Van Eaton has been paid nearly \$68,000 for work and expenses related to the AT&T litigation and the development of an agreement for AT&T's U-verse, the brand name for AT&T's portfolio of Internet protocol (IP)-enabled services including television. Over the period of nearly a year prior to July 1, 2007, Miller & Van Eaton has received payments from the City totalling \$256,881.03. In addition to amounts from the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund SPA, amounts have been paid to Miller & Van Eaton from the Damages and Claimms Fund SPA. As a result of litigation and negotiations, AT&T has reimbursed the City \$217,530.59.
- 2. Anticipated demands upon the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund SPA for the remainder of the fiscal year will exhaust the Fund leaving the City unable to meet legal obligations unless additional funds are appropriated.
- 3. The Office of the Comptroller has reported the status of the Common Council Contingent Fund as of September 14, 2007 showing the fund to be 55% expended or reserved with a balance available of \$2,472,000.

### Summary of Fiscal Impact

- 1. This resolution will reduce the Common Council Contingent Fund by \$100,000 leaving a balance of \$2,372,000 for the 2007 fiscal year.
- 2. Past experience and anticipated circumstances show that the appropriation of \$100,000 to the Outside Counsel/Expert Witness Fund SPA is necessary to assure that the City meets its legal obligations.
