To Whom It May Concern,



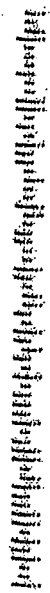

We are in receipt of your claim for \$3,400.00 for damages that occurred on August 10, 2022, when a garbage crew allegedly caused damage to the siding of the garage at your property located at 100-02 N. 76th Street.


In response to this claim, the Department of Public Works(DPW) Sanitation Section investigated this claim by checking maintenance records and checking with crewmembers, and found no record of incidents that occurred at 100-02 N. 76th Street.

There is no evidence that the City is liable for damages in this case. As such, we are denying your claim.
