
Dear Ms. Moore:


This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of 1,279.90, relating to injuries sustained to your ankle on January 29, 2002 when you allegedly slipped on ice at or near 823 North James Lovell St.

An investigation by the Sanitation Division reveals that the accumulation of ice and snow did not exist for the requisite twenty-one days, and therefore the City of Milwaukee cannot be found liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
