The following two organizations are requesting an extension of their LID projects:

- 1. United Community Center
- 2. Ezekiel Community Development Corporation

Both projects have met the LID policy, have matching funds and are under contract.

United Community Center, funded for \$100,000, is requesting an extension of funds and activity to October 31, 2001 to complete the construction of its community gymnasium and pay the general contractor.

Ezekiel CDC received LID funding in the amount of \$160,000. The extension of funds and activity to December 2002 will allow for the continued environmental remediation associated with the construction of new, single family, owner occupied housing in the Midtown area.

Dear Ms. Hawkins:

It has come to my attention that soil remediation monitoring will extend into the end of 2002. Ground water sampling for the reduction of toxic fluid in the ground water will need to be done until the toxic fluid is at a safe level.

Since expenditures during the year of 2001 are expected to be less than originally anticipated, we ask that the remainder of the grant after 2001 expenses be extended for use during the year 2002. We anticipate that reimbursement for Ezekiel time will continue for 2002, also, since funds will be sufficient to pay both Giles Engineering and Ezekiel CDC work.

The following is a rough estimate.

Giles Engineering - 2001 Ezekiel CDC - 2001	\$42,000 9,360
Total	\$ 51,360
Giles Engineering - 2002 Ezekiel CDC - 2002	\$20,000 12,000
	\$32,000

These figures do not add up to the entire \$100,000, but we are requesting a transfer of all remaining monies to the year 2002 because there could be unanticipated costs.
