# 2004 Funding Extension Rationale

- Less Funding
  - Year 2004 reduction of \$1.2 million in CDBG funds
  - Impact of YR 2003 reduction of \$2 million in CDBG funds and \$2 million in HOME funds.
- Larger Service Areas
  - New 2000 census data expands eligible target areas for CDBG/HOME funds, yet funding decreases.
- High accomplishment rate of 2003 subrecipients.
- Sustain level of services to maintain neighborhood stability.


