Dear Ms. Dixon:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$3,000.00, relating to the towing of a vehicle from your property located at 2421 North Palmer Street around the middle of May 2004 that had been deemed a nuisance by the City.

Our investigation reveals that the Department of Neighborhood Services records indicate that on April 15, 2004 they inspected your property, issued an order for removal of a 1994 Buick LeSabre as a nuisance vehicle and posted a placard on the vehicle. The order was mailed on April 16, 2004 to Raymond E. Dixon and Terry L. Howell-Dixon, the listed owners of the property, at the last known address of 2421 North Palmer Street. They were contacted by you and an extension was granted until April 30, 2004. A re-inspection on May 4, 2004 revealed that the tires had been repaired but that the window was still missing. The vehicle was referred for towing. A contractor was at the property on May 16, 2004 and removed the vehicle. The department acted appropriately in this matter and as such, the City would not be liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
