
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Lisa Bradley, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of her employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling westbound on West Fond Du Lac Avenue. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling southbound on North 27th Street, failed to yield the right away by disregarding the red traffic signal, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Bradley sustained injuries to her head, back and left hip. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$24,190.81.
