Dear Council Members:

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimants, Albert C. Manns and Lavonia J. Manns-Jackson, 2866-A North Bremen Street, Milwaukee, WI 53212 allege that on May 26, 2006 their vehicle, a 1995 GMC Van, was towed improperly and subsequently recycled. They claim damages in the amount of \$8,275.00.

Our investigation reveals that their vehicle was properly towed for being Illegally Parked/Unpaid Citations. The tow lot followed applicable regulations for the notice and subsequent recycling of the vehicle. The citations were never challenged or paid. The
