If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by Police Officer Daniel Drewek assigned to District 6, Early Shift.

At the time of my involvement in regards to this investigation/incident, I was equipped with a body worn camera system (Axon Body 3), which captures video and audio and the unit contains camera and battery. I wear the camera affixed to my upper right outer vest carrier pocket. This was done in accordance with the Milwaukee Police Department Standard Operating Procedure regarding Body Worn Cameras.

On 2/18/22, at 5:56 pm, while by myself on squad 6230, was dispatched to 110 W. Edgerton for a sick/injured call where a subject's Apple watch alerted of a fall. The actual incident address was 5067 S. Howell Ave which is the restaurant Jalapeno Loco.

Upon arrival, MFD engine Engine 14, blue shift, Lt. Bill Butlaff, were treating an elderly female that had fallen on the ground outside. The female, Paula J. Schmitt (w/f, 1/12/54) sitting inside on the bench by the exit. She had some bruising and bleeding to the front of her face and she was extremely intoxicated. I asked her what happened and in a slurred voice stated she was coming to get food, had three margaritas, and fell outside. She did not remember if she blacked out.

Spoke to employee Alejandro Saynes (w/m, 10/30/88) who said he saw the female walking outside carrying two bags of food and went to stepped outside she slipped on the step and fell.

She was later conveyed to St. Luke's Hospital for intoxication and possible injuries from the fall by Bell 445.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/9/2022 at 1:30 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
