File # 071025 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a Wisconsin Internet Crimes Against Children Grant.

### Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to apply for, accept and fund a Wisconsin Internet Crimes Against Children grant project from the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation.
- 2. This is a continuing grant. On November 15, 2005 the Common Council adopted CCFN 050834 that authorized MPD to apply for, accept and fund a Wisconsin Internet Crimes Against Children Grant in the amount of \$75,000 with a grantor share of \$75,000 and a city share of \$0.

# **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of the project is to establish and fund a multi-agency, interdisciplinary task force to investigate and prosecute Internet crimes against children. This task force includes Wisconsin Department of Justice special agents and MPD officers.
- 2. The task force investigates the computer-facilitated sexual exploitation of children on the Internet, conducting both proactive investigations as well as responding to requests for investigative assistance from local law enforcement agencies in Wisconsin.
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of January 1, 2007 to December 30, 2008.

## **Fiscal Impact**

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$85,000 provided by the grantor.
- 2. Grant monies fund overtime for officers working in the MPD Sensitive Crimes Division (\$69,840) as well as funding for training, computer equipment and Internet and cell phone services.
