This report is written by PO Benjmain SPITZER, Assigned to District Two, Late Power.

On Monday, April 1st, 2019 at 2:01 AM while assigned to SQ 2464, PO Benjamin SPITZER and I, were dispatched to 1226 W. National Ave, Amnesia, to assist SQ 2330, PO RAMOS and PO SANCHEZ-ALCANTAR, with a substantial battery complaint.

The victim, identified as Gabriel FELIX-ROQUE (W/M, 03-24-79), was a patron inside of the listed tavern with a friend, identified as Leandro FELIX-ROQUE (W/M, 01-12-85). After the bar closed Gabriel FELIX-ROQUE was confronted by the suspect, identified as Renzo RASCON-GAMBOA (W/M, 04-28-00), and a fight ensued in the street. As a result of the fight Gabriel FELIX-ROQUE sustained a minor laceration to his head which required three stitches to close. The fight allegedly occurred due to Gabriel FELIX-ROQUE and Renzo RASCON-GAMBOA having some type of altercation within the tavern prior to bar close.

The owner of Amnesia, identified as Ruben ALBANIL-COYOTT (W/M, 06-08-85), was on scene. ALBANIL-COYOTT stated he was not downstairs when the altercation occurred, and he was upstairs in the upper unit. ALBANIL-COYOTT stated he was advised by the unidentified doorman, who was no longer on scene, that a fight was happening in the street. ALBANIL-COYOTT did not recognize any subjects inside of the tavern as patrons. ALBANIL-COYOTT was cooperative with the investigation.

I spoke with the DJ, identified as Mario FLORES-GIRON (W/M, 07-22-84), who stated some of the

subjects involved in the fight were patrons prior to bar close. FLORES-GIRON stated he was putting away his equipment, and did not observe the fight.

ALBANIL-COYOTT provided me with the bartender's license, identified as Brenda Y. TAPIA-LEON (W/F, 05-17-88, Class D#0230262), who left prior to Police arrival, and was no longer on scene.

No tavern violations observed.

On Saturday June 8, 2019 at 12:04am P.O. MUNOZ and I were dispatched to the address of 1256 W National Ave to investigate a Battery Complaint. At that time the suspect, later identified as Evin Philip ROONEY (W/M 06-12-2000), was not on scene. ROONEY intentionally and without consent, closed fist, punched one of the security guards on the right side of their face on scene. ROONEY fled the scene afterwards.

Later in the night ROONEY was located and arrested. An initial mirandized interview of ROONEY revealed that he freely walked into the listed bar without being asked ID. ROONEY also stated he was served multiple alcoholic beverages during his time at the location.

No interview of the owner or bartenders was conducted due to the fact that this information was given later on in the night.



Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.







He repeatedly told me it was a "loud music establishment" and that there wasn't much they could do about it. Only after I continued to explain the issue to him did he state he would send someone to check it out. Given his reaction it seemed like he was not taking our issue seriously. We were left with the impression that we had done something wrong by calling in a complaint. Did we do something wrong? He refused to provide his name and the dispatcher did not provide a number so I am not sure if a record was made.

This leaves us with a couple of questions:

- 1. Is this the correct response from the police to a noise complaint and if not what do the police need from us to assist in addressing this issue?
- 2. What can we do to address this ongoing problem with the LVL club playing loud bass at 1am? It seems like they recently upgraded their sound system or are playing music much louder because it is not uncommon for us to hear the bass even in the back of our home.





- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
