Dear Commissioners:

I am requesting that the position of Vehicle Operations Instructor continue to be classified as exempt from competitive examination, pursuant to Fire and Police Commission Rule V, Sections 1 and 6. This position is assigned to the Bureau of EMS, Training, and Education, Training Division.

The Vehicle Operations Instructor, a sworn position represented by Local 215, Milwaukee Professional Fire Fighters' Association, must either be a current Heavy Equipment Operator or have held the position. State of Wisconsin certification as Driver/Operator-Pumper and Driver/Operator-Aerial is also required. Additionally, a high degree of knowledge in the operation of firefighting tools, equipment, and apparatus is needed, as well as the ability to communicate with and teach others with awareness of ethnic and lifestyle diversity. The candidate must be able to successfully motivate, evaluate, direct, and coordinate others' activities. Oral and written reporting must be clear, concise, and accurate. This position requires the ability to effectively interact with all MFD divisions, other City departments, and external agencies to obtain logistical support for the purpose of providing effective training and operations. The candidate must exhibit a high degree of integrity and professionalism.

Exemption is appropriate given that the Vehicle Operations Instructor position requires a wide range of skills in the mission-critical responsibilities of assisting the Vehicle Operations Training Coordinator with the development, instruction, and coordination of all fire department equipment and vehicle operators. The following primary job duties will have to be fulfilled:

- Trains and qualifies department members in driving, pumping, aerial ladder operations, and the operations of special equipment.
- Directs and assists with in-service programs, online company-based training, and cadet, recruit, and probationary firefighter training.
- Performs annual testing on pumping engines and aerial ladders. Tests performance of newly acquired firefighting apparatus, tools, and equipment.



- Works with the Construction and Maintenance Division to expedite the specification, maintenance, and repair of department vehicles.
- Maintains records and monitors department members' qualification levels. Trains Heavy Equipment Operators to the level of field qualifiers.

We currently have a vacancy in the position due to a retirement. We followed an open, well-documented procedure to select a candidate to fill this position. I have attached a current job description.
