**Subject:** Paving Program Outcomes for 2016 & 2017

---

The following information is in response to your question regarding the miles of streets paved in 2016 and 2017, the proposed paving program for 2018 and the criteria for prioritizing paving projects.

The miles of streets paved in 2016 and 2017 appear in the table below. The paving program for 2018 has not been finalized. Although the Department of Public Works does not separately publish a map of paving project locations, Map Milwaukee contains a paving program layer depicting current and proposed projects.

The Department utilizes a number of criteria to prioritize paving projects. Programming is generally driven by the condition of the roadway. The condition is based on visual and physical inspection of the roadway by Field Engineering personnel. The Department also uses the Pavement Management Matrix program.
