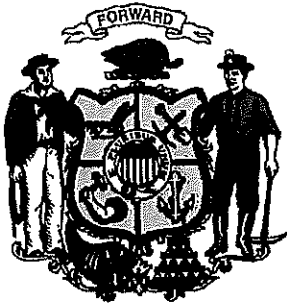

It was brought to my attention that a client under our supervision, Paige Lindlbauer, has applied for a bartender license from the City of Milwaukee. Client Lindlbauer is currently on an a 12-month Probation term that is scheduled to discharge on 12/02/2022 for the offense of OWI 2nd.

This letter is to inform you that such a licensure would be in violation of their rules/conditions of supervision. If circumstances change, we will take measures appropriately, including action that may affect such licensure. We made this decision based in part, on the following information:
