





We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced into and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, State Farm Insurance Company, Attn: Beth DeRosier, Claim Representative, P.O. Box 82613, Lincoln NE 68501-2613, allege on their behalf and that of their insured, Michelle Williams, that Williams was involved in an auto accident on August 28, 2007 at North 15th Street and West State Street because she ran the stop sign at this location which was damaged and not visible to southbound traffic. They seek a contribution in this matter for a claim in the amount of \$37,068.18.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division (ISD) reviewed their records and those of the DPW Call Center relative to this incident. The accident report reflected that the ISD responded to the accident scene on that date and repaired the stop sign. The ISD records reflected that it had no prior notice of the damaged stop sign. Since the City had no notice of this condition, it cannot be held liable, as such, we recommend denial of the claim.

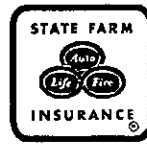

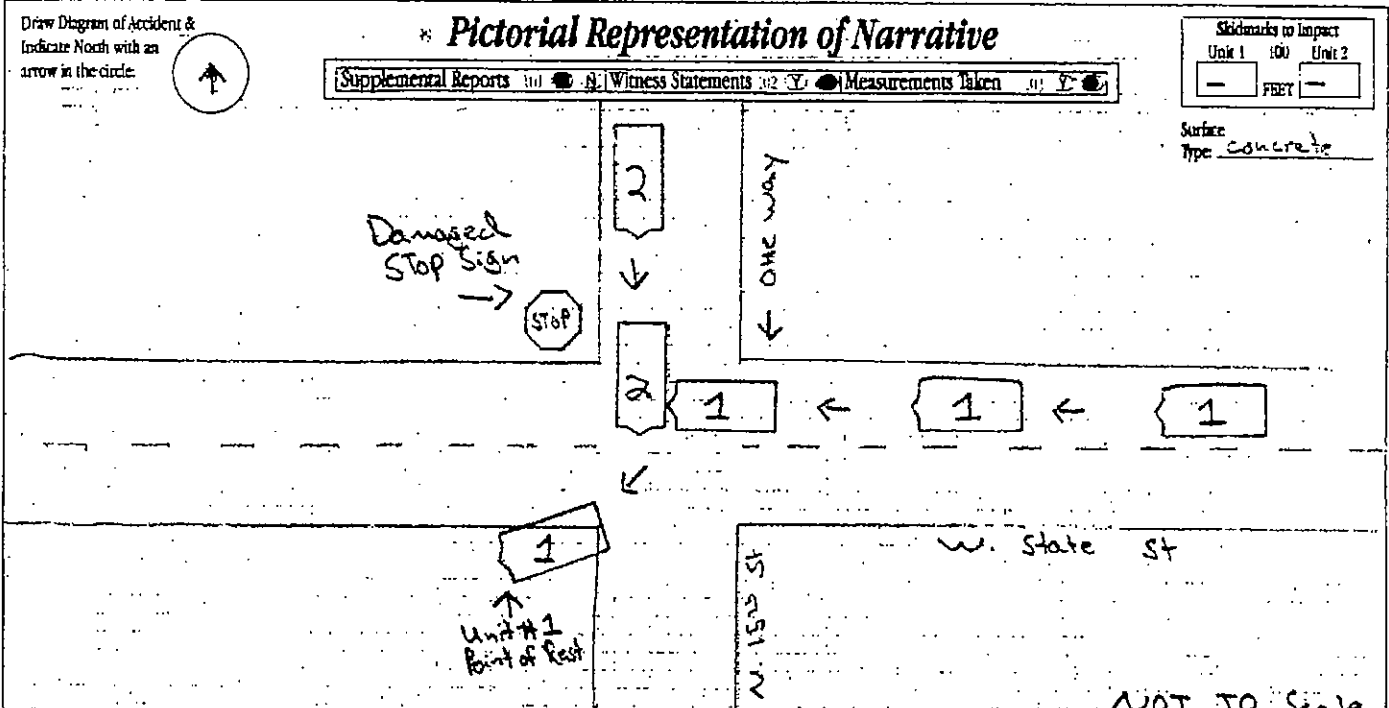

When WILLIAMS entered the intersection her auto was struck by the westbound auto driven by MARQUARDT-O'KEEFE. WILLIAMS stated that after the accident she observed the stop sign for southbound traffic on N 15th St at W State St had been damaged and was facing eastbound traffic on W State St. I inspected the stop sign and observed that someone had removed the wedge that holds the sign in place and moved the sign and pole so the sign faced eastbound traffic on W State St. I later notified the City of Milwaukee Department of Electrical Services who responded and repaired the stop sign.</p> <p>I interviewed MARQUARDT-O'KEEFE regarding the accident. MARQUARDT-O'KEEFE stated she was westbound on W State St in the 1400 block. She stated as she approached the intersection of W State St and N 15th St the southbound auto driven by WILLIAMS entered the intersection and she was unable to avoid the collision. MARQUARDT-O'KEEFE complained of pain to her mid chest and mid back. I pointed out the position of the damaged stop sign and informed MARQUARDT-O'KEEFE that an unknown person had damaged the sign and altered its position. MARQUARDT-O'KEEFE was transported to Sinia Hospital by Bell Ambulance #423 for treatment.</p>

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Theresa Payton Myrick, 8047 North 47th Street, Brown Deer, WI 53223, alleges that on September 20, 2009, she sustained damages to when a City sewer backed up into the basement of her property located at 4753 North 19th Place. She claims damages in the amount of \$7,500.00.

Our investigation reveals that the Milwaukee Water Works-Distribution Division has no records of any recent water main breaks or repair activity in this area. In addition, their control center did not receive any recent phone calls or complaints regarding this area. The Infrastructure Services Division (ISD) records indicate that on September 20, 2009, they responded to a call of a backwater at 4753 North 19th Place. The ISD found the City main sewer to be clogged with grease. They used a sewer jet to open the clog, clean the sewer and restore it to proper working order. The sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and was last cleaned, prior to this incident, on December 19, 2006. Because the sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and the City did not have notice of any problems with the sewer, the City cannot be held liable. Therefore we recommend that this claim be denied.

The following information should also be submitted to allow the City to promptly act on your claim:

1. Proof of the amount of the claim by means of either itemized receipts or two itemized estimates.
2. A phone number where the claimant can be reached during business hours.
3. As detailed a description of the incident as possible, including the date, time and place.

This claim is in response to an incident I had with my Chrysler Town and Country van on Sunday, September 27, 2009 at 11:45 am. While traveling with my 9 year old daughter west bound on Capitol Drive just feet past 76th street, I started to turn into the south east entrance of the Times Square Shopping Mall parking lot and my tire got caught in a pothole in the shoulder of the road. I lost control of the car and could barely get the car several feet into the parking lot because I could not steer the car. I then got out of the car to examine the problem, only to see that both tires were pointing inward. I thus proceeded to try to right the car and move ahead, out of the way of others who were trying to enter the parking lot, but was unable to because the car would not move. I called Dennis's Towing Service to tow my car because it was not drivable. The tow driver looked underneath the car while hooking it up to lift on the flat bed truck and stated the tie rod broke.

I am officially filing a claim for the towing and repair charges enclosed. This was a very scary and dangerous situation. Being that construction is occurring on 76th street just a few feet north of Capitol Drive, the barricades were out several feet into Capitol Drive. Thus once past the protruding barricades, the Times Square entrance comes up quite quickly thus not allowing one to make a sharper turn and avoid this pothole. I am only thankful that others who were trying to turn into that same lot, as I was blocking 3/4's of the entrance, did not hit my van and cause an accident whereby my daughter or myself or another drive could have been hurt. Please take note of the photos I have enclosed to show you this destructive and dangerous pothole. In addition, as you can see by the photos the entire shoulder is a mess and a danger.

As stated, earlier, I had the car towed to Dennis's Service and they repaired the tie rod and realigned the car on Monday, September 28, 2009.

In conclusion, I am requesting that the City of Milwaukee reimburse my towing and tie rod repair expenses of \$349.03 (please note enclosed receipt) due to the negligence of poor and dangerous street maintenance. All of this could have most certainly been avoided, had there not been this enormous pothole in the shoulder of the road.

Thank you for your time and prompt attention to this claim. I will look forward to hearing from you.

Analysis

This resolution expresses the City of Milwaukee's support for federal legislation to increase funding for the federal Housing Trust Fund, particularly H.R. 3068 or H.R. 3766, each of which allocates \$1 billion in Troubled Assets Relief Program funds to the Housing Trust Fund. This resolution further urges all members of the U.S. Congress to support passage of this legislation.

Body

Whereas, Milwaukee and other urban communities across the nation face both a housing foreclosure crisis and an acute need for decent, affordable housing, particularly housing for low-income households and the homeless; and

Whereas, In 1992, the U. S. Congress established a federal Housing Trust Fund for the purposes of increasing and preserving the supply of rental housing for low-income households, including homeless families, and increasing homeownership for low-income families; and

Whereas, The federal Housing Trust Fund is funded by: 1) an annual set-aside, by both the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation and Federal National Mortgage Association, in an amount equal to 65% of 4.2 basis points for each dollar of unpaid principal balance of the enterprise's total new business purchases; 2) any amounts appropriated, transferred or credited to the Housing Trust Fund under any other provisions of law; and

Whereas, Federal Housing Trust Fund allocations are distributed to state housing agencies in all 50 states using a need-based formula; and

Whereas, In 2009, Representative Barney Frank of Massachusetts, along with several other members of Congress, introduced two similar bills -- H.R. 3068 and H.R. 3766 of the first session of the 111th Congress -- that direct the Secretary of the Treasury to transfer \$1 billion in Troubled Assets Relief Program ("TARP") funds to the Housing Trust Fund to provide affordable rental housing and relief to homeowners and neighborhoods impacted by the current housing crisis; and

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee created its own Housing Trust Fund in 2006 to provide financial support to developers and governmental entities in the acquisition, construction, rehabilitation and modification of affordable and accessible housing for low-income households, including households that are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, and to finance support services that assist low-income households in obtaining and maintaining affordable housing; and

Whereas, Federal Housing Trust Fund dollars granted to the State of Wisconsin or any of its housing-related instrumentalities could supplement expenditures of City Housing Trust Fund dollars, thereby allowing more low-income renters, homeowners and homeless individuals to benefit from affordable housing initiatives in Milwaukee; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the City of Milwaukee supports legislation to increase funding for the federal Housing Trust Fund, particularly H.R. 3068 or H.R. 3766, and urges all members of the U.S. Congress to support passage of this legislation; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Clerk shall send a copy of this resolution to each member of Wisconsin's Congressional delegation.


