## Potential Fiscal Impact of Supplementary Pay for Employees on Military Duty

The Budget Office and DER estimate that the cost of this proposal ranges from \$170,000-\$681,000 for currently activated employees up to a maximum annual liability of \$3 million if all eligible military personnel are activated. The City currently provides additional health benefits to city employees activated to military service. The City pays 100% of the cost of health and dental insurance for any City Employee with family coverage in active military service, including the employee premiums. In 2005, these supplemental benefits will cost the city an estimated \$365,000.
