Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. > Alderman Bauman:

>

> At a recent neighborhood meeting I met . I told her about the Patel Family liquor license attempt/proposed inter-family transfer of ownership from the May meeting and that the neighbors were told that the current Patel Family member has an active beer license through July. If you recall the last time this license came up the neighborhood complained that the store was too close to the school. Then we were told that the issue was that the school's entrance was more than 300 feet from the store, making it allowable. The entrance was on the West side of the building.

> told me that occurrences at the store make it unsafe for the children at dismissal and that the 8th grade is dismissed from the East side of the building which would make the school entrance within 300 feet of the beer sales. She also described a video one of her staff took of an incident.

>

> The Shipwreck Park is nearing completion and Hunger Task Force plans to serve summer meals from this location. We will not serve adults there (as we do with parents at Merrill Park.) This neighborhood amenity is welcomed and at povious counter-purpose to the single can sales of beer at Milwaukee Foods.

> Can you advise on the timing of the License Committee and if in fact this license will be up for review in July? How can Messmer St. Rose go on record or share any video evidence of challenges that the loitering creates?

> As a resident I can organize additional testimony when I know what the date and time are. We will not oppose food or cigarette sales but we will oppose beer sales.

This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 07/31/2019 at 5:20am officers were dispatched to an Entry complaint at Milwaukee Food Grocery Store, 2903 W. Clybourn Av. The officer spoke with the manager, who stated he got a call from his alarm company at about 4:51am that the alarm was going off. When he arrived he found the rear door open and called the police. The officer cleared the building and the manager found that cigarettes were taken. The applicant did arrive and was cooperative.
2. On 11/21/2019 at 8:07pm officers were dispatched to a Theft complaint at Milwaukee Food Mart, 2903 W. Clybourn Av. The officer interviewed the clerk, who stated a known subject came in the business and took merchandise without paying for it. The officer gave the clerk information on how to obtain a restraining order.

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3. On 01/15/21 at 5:13pm, officers were dispatched to a Theft at Milwaukee Foods Grocery and Deli (2903 W. Clybourn) for a Theft from Person. Officers interviewed the victim who stated he was in line at the checkout, with his firearm sticking out of his pocket, when an unknown juvenile removed it and ran out of the store. The victim gave chase but stopped when the suspect turned and pointed it. The entire incident was captured on video surveillance and the employees were cooperative turning it over to police.

4. On 04/15/21 officers conducted a License Premise check at 2903 W. Clybourn Ave. (Milwaukee Foods Grocery and Deli). Complaints of drug dealing were addressed with the employee. The employee was cooperative with police and stated he works very close with bicycle squads and reports incidents to them. The employee further stated he addresses people who loiter outside of the store and has multiple no loitering signs posted. No violations were observed during the contact.

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5. On 08/26/21 at 5:14pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2903 W. Clybourn Street for a property damage complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject had smash the window of an employee's vehicle which was parked in the rear parking lot. The subject was located and cited for the violation.

On 8-26-21, at approximately 5:14pm, while on patrol, Sq 3251, Police Officer Andrew GALLENBERG and I were dispatched to 2903 w Clybourn St, in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI, to investigate property damage. upon arrival we interviewed the caller, who identified himself as Dixit PATEL (w/m 07-30-88) who stated that on 8-26-21, at approx. 4:50pm, at the rear of 2903 w Clybourn St, a black male subject wearing a red t-shirt and black pants intentionally and without consent smashed the rear view windshield to his uncle's red 2013 town and country minivan bearing WI 814-pvl causing approximately \$400 damages. PATEL showed me video surveillance of the subject. We located the subject at 405 n 27th St, and he identified himself as Alphonso GIVENS (b/m 03-24-79). GIVENS admitted that he smashed the window with a brick after PATEL intentionally hit him because he was inside the business stealing. GIVENS was issued a citation for adult vandalism.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/28/2022 at 11:45 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
