On April 29, 2005, a Milwaukee County Police Officer, shot and killed my dog. The Police Officer was at the wrong address. The police report is enclosed.

Signs are posted to beware of dog around my residence/place of business and it is well lite. Neighbors have even warned visitors of the dog's presence.

I have had the dog (King) for approximately seven years. King was trained along side of my dog Ralph, which is my practice, to watch for visitors or trespassers because I operate a business in my home. I have a lot of valuable tools on the premises.

I have suffered a great loss. I don't have the protection and I will not be able to train another dog, in the same manner, as I have in the past. My premises will not be protected for an undetermined amount of time.

At your request to state the amount of damages in writing, I seek \$5000 (five thousand dollars) for damages. I understand this to be the limit in small claims. My lost is worth much more for the very reason stated above.
