1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The purpose of this project is to conduct a long-term evaluation of the condition of housing units that underwent lead hazard control interventions from 1994-1995 as a part of the HUD Lead-Based Paint Evaluation. The Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program will work in cooperation with the NCLSH and the University of Cincinnati to contact current property owners and tenants residing in 150 households targeted for long-term follow-up. Further, the Health Department will provide supportive information to a private risk assessment firm which will conduct environmental sampling in 150 housing units to be studied.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Childhood lead poisoning prevention is a major strategic goal and department objective within the Home Environmental Health and the Maternal and Child Health Department of the Health Department.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

A local presence in implementing this study is needed by both the NCLSH and the University of Cincinnati. The funds to be received under this contract are minimal and based on the CLPPP time needed to support this initiative.
