There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

I am writing to express my objection to the Public Entertainment Premises license for Mother's.

Below is a section of a Milwaukee Journal Sentinel article from April 16th, 2025 in which the paper interviews Vanessa Rose (proprietor of Mother's).

The adjoining 16-space parking lot will have room for events, too, and with the restaurant opening in June, Mother's plans to open a tent for drag shows every Friday and Saturday during Pride Month. She's particularly excited about the building's potential during Halloween season, too, when she hopes to hold

"spooky drag" or "goth drag" shows in the parking lot.

"With the Victorian style and architecture of the building, we're going to have a killer Halloween," she said. "We're already looking forward to making it extra spooky come fall."

My concerns are the outdoor events in a tent.

Drag shows will involve loud music and clapping and cheering from spectators. How can they abide by noise ordinances with this being outside in a tent? Also, with the location of the tent in the parking lot, the patrons will be parking all over our neighborhood causing congestion. The plan is for eight shows in June (every Friday and Saturday) and more in October. Will this be expanded to more weekend events?

I do not know of any restaurant/bar that is allowed to have outdoor entertainment on a regular basis in this residential neighborhood. This is a quiet neighborhood:

Objection to public entertainment premises license

Reasons:

- 1) Loud outdoor entertainment in a residential area.
- 2) Parking congestion in residential area.
- 3) Adult entertainment in a residential area.

My concerns with the business plan include loud outdoor events in tents and in the parking lot in a residential area. In the Milwaukee Journal-Sentinel and On Milwaukee, the proprietor stated to the media that they want to have these events every weekend in June and in October for Halloween. There is fair weather in between, so I'm guessing they will want more events. My concerns include loud noise and parking congestion in a quiet residential area that has not seen this type of activity before. Noise carries very easily with the houses so close together. I have lived here for 20 years and this would be a drastic change.

The proposed events will draw large crowds for a space that is not appropriate for such events. Where will people park if the parking lot is used for events? The previous business has been a restaurant for the past 5 years without any problems except a loud band thankfully only one evening last summer.



The proprietor also stated to the media that they were going to have adult entertainment (drag shows), something that has <u>never</u> been in this neighborhood. This is a quiet residential area. There is a school and a church one block away.

On Monday, May 19, 2025, at 10:30 am, my partner Police Officer Michael Ward and I met with licensee/agent Bradford Long at 2900 S. Kinnickinnic Avenue. The location is currently closed, and does have a parking lot located on the southeast side of the property, which does have an exterior camera facing the lot and rear door.

LONG plans to open in June, and on Thursdays-Mondays, and have Tuesdays and Wednesdays as prepping days or for private bookings. The location currently has one exterior camera and no interior cameras. LONG plans to add cameras in the future, which will face the entry and exit doors and register area. The standing complainant form was provided along with a District 6 community contact guide. LONG will be adding the business address so it may be easy to see.




City Concentration Map for 2900 S Kinnickinnic Av

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/24/2025 at 8:30 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
