Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations): The 2020 Operation Grant will provide funding for the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to participate in Operation Legend, a federal initiative led by the United States Attorney's Office to reduce violent crime within the City of Milwaukee. Grant funds will be used for overtime for task force personnel and to purchase a ballistic identification machine, vehicles, equipment, and computer software. Additional funding will be used to hire a civilian Police Services Specialist Investigator (PSSI) to serve as a liaison between task forces.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives: Operation Legend task forces will investigate violent firearm offenses, support federal prosecutions to reduce violent crime, and apprehend and prosecute subjects who have been charged with violent felony crimes.
