This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/23/24 at 11:19p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. The agent was on scene and advised officers a fight took place inside the establishment and a subject pulled out a gun. The agent stated they search males; therefore, they think a female snuck the gun in her purse. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
2. On 02/13/24 at 9:55p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers observed parking issues related to the business and asked an employee to make an announcement to have patrons legally park their cars. Officers further advised the agent the license's that were posted were not current. The agent later walked into the District to show the current licenses.

3. On 08/04/24 at 4:20p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in Battery that occurred at approximately 12:50a.m., in front of 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers were advised the victim had just left the club, when two suspects who were in the club earlier, battered her. The victim stated they didn't call the police at the time of the incident, since the suspects fled immediately after.

4. On 10/29/24 at 9:32p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in Domestic Violence complaint that occurred at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson. Officers were advised the victim was at the club, when the suspect entered the business and caused a disturbance, knocking the victim's food to the ground. The suspect also made a threat, when the victim comes outside, they would shoot them. Security was advised and told the victim to go to the District and file a complaint.

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5. On 06/11/25 at 12:16a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a battery at 2901 N Dr William Finlayson Dr. The caller stated a security guard held them while another subject was hitting them in the face. The business denied any physical fight took place, however, after viewing video surveillance, officers did observe a subject wearing a badge around their neck, holding the victim, while another subject punched the victim in the face. The Agent was on scene and stated they did not recognize either of the subjects attacking the victim.
6. On 05/26/26 at 5:39p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in Battery that occurred on 05/20/26 at approximately 1:00a.m. The victim stated they exited the bar at close and was attacked by three subjects, who were striking them with beer bottles. The victim received 10 stitches and provided video of the incident from their personal cell phone, which was uploaded to evidence.com. The business did not call the police, however, it is not noted they were aware the fight took place.

This report is written by P.O. Jonathan ENDERLE, assigned to District 5, Late Shift.

DISPATCH & INITIAL OBSERVATIONS

On Wednesday, June 11th, 2025, at 12:16 A.M., while assigned to Squad 5330 with P.O. Tashumi WILLIAMS, operating a marked police vehicle, in full duty uniform, with body-worn camera worn and activated, I was dispatched to the intersection of N. Dr. William Finlayson Dr. and W. Locust St. for a Battery - In Progress call. The caller stated that she had been assaulted by a security guard at Savoy's Night Club at 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson St., and was waiting in a 2025 Nissan Rogue with the hazard lights on parked on N. Dr. William Finlayson Dr. Upon arrival I observed a Nissan Rogue parked facing northbound on N. Dr. William Finlayson Dr., where I made contact with a F/B subject, later identified as the caller/victim, Antoinette B. BATES (F/B 04/24/1989).

INTERVIEW OF CALLER (BATES)

BATES stated the incident started when she and an employee at Savoy's, whom she knew, later spoken to and identified as ALEXZANDER K. LOVE (M/B 11/02/1992), had been repeatedly entering and exiting through a back door to the patio. BATES stated that the owner of the property, later spoken to and identified as Tina M. JOHNSON-WILLIAMS (F/B 06/01/1967), after hearing the door slam, had shouted "Who's gonna pay for that fucking door". BATES then said that LOVE would be responsible for it.

BATES stated that then a woman, who she believed to be JOHNSON-WILLIAMS' niece, shouted at BATES, saying "nobody disrespects my titi". BATES responded that she was not disrespecting JOHNSON-WILLIAMS, as BATES knew JOHNSON-WILLIAMS and was friendly with her. BATES stated that the woman then shouted "bitch I'll bleed you". BATES responded "I ain't got time for that". BATES stated that the woman then "got to running up on me", grabbing BATES' hair. BATES stated that a security guard, who she could not identify, started holding her and choking her, and the woman began hitting BATES in the face. I asked whether BATES required medical attention and she stated she did not.

INVESTIGATION AT 2901 N. DR. WILLIAM FINLAYSON ST. (SAVOY'S)

After interviewing BATES we changed locations to 2901 N. Dr. William Finlayson St. to investigate at Savoy's. I spoke to a security guard, verbally identified as Kevin E. BLACKMAN (M/B 09/15/1988), and a barback, verbally identified as Alexzander K. LOVE (M/B 11/02/1992). P.O. WILLIAMS spoke to the owner of the property, Tina L. JOHNSON (06/01/1967).

LICENSED PERSON INVOLVED - SECURITY GUARD (BLACKMAN)

BLACKMAN is the security guard at the door at Savoy's. BLACKMAN was armed with a handgun in a holster across his chest. BLACKMAN stated that he did not observe any physical fight occur. BLACKMAN stated that he observed a verbal argument between individuals who he recognized as "regulars" but could not identify, and the victim BATES. BLACKMAN stated that as a matter of policy, when individuals are engaged in loud verbal arguments, both parties are ejected from the bar, and that he escorted BATES and the other parties out the door. BATES stated that he did not observe any physical altercation, but that he would not have been aware of anything that might have happened after exiting the door.

LICENSED PERSON INVOLVED - BARBACK (LOVE)

LOVE is employed as a barback at Savoy's. LOVE stated he knows the victim BATES and is friendly with her. LOVE stated that he did recall the incident where JOHNSON asked who would pay for the door, but that he did not recall any physical fight stemming from the incident. LOVE stated that he had observed that BATES was starting to annoy some of the patrons in the patio area. LOVE stated that he was trying to get BATES to go back into the main bar area to get her away from the individuals in the patio. LOVE stated that BATES then became upset with his efforts to get her to leave and slammed the door, prompting JOHNSON to ask who would pay for any damages to the door.

BUSINESS AGENT - OWNER (JOHNSON)

P.O. WILLIAMS and I spoke to JOHNSON regarding the incident. When we stated we were here regarding a fight at the location, JOHNSON appeared surprised, stating that there was no fight that had occurred here. I asked JOHNSON whether her niece had been at this location tonight. JOHNSON stated no niece had been here, but her granddaughter had been here, and had left around 10:30 P.M.

SECURITY FOOTAGE

JOHNSON allowed us to view security footage of the patio area where the incident was supposed to have occurred. The timestamps on the video were off, being 1 hour late. At 10:37 P.M. on the video (meaning 11:37 P.M. actual), I observed a M/B subject, wearing a light-colored T-shirt, and an apparent badge/necklace around his neck, approach BATES, grabbing her, and another unidentified subject, possibly M/B, approximately 5'09", 150lb, punching BATES in the face. Upon seeing this, JOHNSON appeared surprised, and asked to rewind the footage. I asked JOHNSON if she knew the two individuals attacking BATES. JOHNSON stated she did not.

This report is written by PO Monica ROEKER, assigned to District 5, Early Power Shift.

On Tuesday May 26th, 2026, at approximately 5:39 PM I received a walk in complaint of a Substantial Battery. Victim identified as Gabrel BLEDSOE, B/F, 07/23/1987, stated that on 05/19/2026 at approximately 10:00 PM her and her friend identified as Shania D. SMITH, B/F, 10/24/1989 went to 2901 N 5th St, (Savoy's Bar and Grill), which is located in the city and county of Milwaukee. BLEDSOE stated her and SMITH were remembering one of their friends that was recently killed and wanted to eat wings at Savoy's. BLEDSOE stated they stayed at Savoy's until bar close. BLEDSOE stated that one 05/20/2026 at approximately 1:00 AM she walked outside of the bar and observed 3 females fighting her friend SMITH. BLEDSOE stated she did not know what was going on but remembers those 3 same females approached her and started to strike multiple times to the face, and body with a closed fist and beer bottles. BLEDSOE stated she attempted to fight back but due to also being intoxicated she could only cover herself. BLEDSOE stated she remembers all 3 females having beer bottles and striking her multiple times to the face with the beer bottles. BLEDSOE stated she did not remember how the physical fight ended and only remembers waking up at Froedtert Hospital. BLEDSOE stated while she was at Froedtert Hospital she was taken care of by Doctor Thomas GRAWLEY. BLEDSOE stated Doctor GRAWLEY advised her she received 10 stitches to her left eyebrow. BLEDSOE stated that after she was discharged from the hospital, she attempted to find the 3 female's information for the police to file a report. BLEDSOE stated she could not find the proper information.

It should be noted I did observe stitches on BLEDSOE left eyebrow.

BLEDSOE described the suspect as followed:

Suspect 1 Charrish L. WINFORY, B/F, 08/11/1988

Suspect 2 Bianca JACKSON, possible DOB 04/24/1989.

Suspect 3, Black Female

PO REEL from squad 5230 took 6 photos of BLEDSOE injury.

BLEDSOE provided a copy of the medical discharge paperwork, which was submitted to evidence.com. BLEDSOE stated she also has a video of the incident on her phone which an evidence.com link was sent to her to upload video.

A call was placed in D4 board to locate suspect.

I conducted a search on our Tritech system for possible matches for "Charrish WINFORY". I was able to come up with a possible match of Charrish L. WINFORY, B/F, 08/11/1988. I then created a photo array with WINFORY as the intended target.

I prepared a photo array of WINFORY (photo array #84809). The eight-folder blind method was used with the last two folders blank. PO SPENCE shuffled the array and placed the photos into the folders. This was

done so I would not know what folder the target was in while presenting the array.

On 05/27/2026 at approximately 5:45 PM BLEDSOE came to the district station to be presented a photo array.

BLEDSOE was then brought to a private room for a photo array to be conducted. BLEDSOE was provided a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department Photo Array Identification form, and she read along as I read aloud the form. BLEDSOE stated she understood the photo array procedures and circled "yes" on the form. BLEDSOE then signed the form indicating she read and understood the instructions and was prepared to review the photographs.

I presented the folders to BLEDSOE beginning with the folder marked #1. BLEDSOE viewed the folders marked 1,2,3,5,6,7, and BLEDSOE answered no to these folders. When BLEDSOE was presented with folder marked #4 she stated, "yes this is her". BLEDSOE later signed and dated the back of the photo in the folder marked #4.

I finished presenting the array to BLEDSOE and BLEDSOE circled she has "identified" a perpetrator in this offense and wrote "4" to identify the folder number of the photo she identified as "Charrish WINFORY." BLEDSOE stated that she was "positive" that she identified the right person. BLEDSOE signed and dated the bottom of the form.

Photo Array was then inventoried with inventory number C2605260127.

I then submitted a Suspect Alert and Temp Felony Want for WINFORY.

BLEDSOE was ordered into the ADA Office for 05/28/2026 at 1:30 PM

BLEDSOE was issued a PV-17

BLEDSOE was issued a Community Contact Card

I submitted a follow up email to squad 5165 to conduct video recovery of the incident.

The business did not call for police, however, it is not noted if they were aware the fight took place
