REASON FOR REQUEST:

Christopher Bruch, a City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was stopped on West Capitol Drive for a red traffic signal at the intersection with North 42nd Street. The uninsured motorist, who was proceeding westbound on West Capitol Drive, failed to stop and rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Bruch sustained an injury to his neck, back and right shoulder. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$25,617.61.
