REASON FOR REQUEST:

John C. Hefley, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating an M.P.D. motorcycle that was traveling eastbound on W. Lisbon Ave. with emergency lights and siren activated. As the City motorcycle entered the intersection of W. Lisbon Ave. and N. 27^{th} St., the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding northbound on N. 27^{th} St., failed to yield the right-of-way and collided with the City motorcycle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

From November 1, 2009 to November 1, 2011, the minimum Uninsured Motorist coverage required by Wis. Stat. § 632.32(4)(a)1 was \$100,000.00 per accident. Since this accident occurred on May 16, 2011, Officer Hefley's attorney is contending that Wis. Stat. § 62.67 incorporated the minimum Uninsured Motorist coverage required by Wis. Stat. § 632.32(4)(a)1.

Officer Hefley sustained injuries to his neck, right shoulder, right elbow, and fractures to his right leg/ankle. The treating physician has indicated there is a permanent injury to the right knee. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$52,457.10.
