## Sister City, Irpin Ukraine

Due to the ongoing war in Ukraine the main contact with Irpin has been via e-mails with our primary focus on raising funds to provide humanitarian aid to support Ukraine in general. This effort has consumed all of our attention and as a result we have decided not to renew this relationship when our 5 year commitment expires.

To date we have raised and sent \$200, 000 to Ukraine

### 2022/2023 List of Activity

Mayor Johnson has joined our Sunday Service and spoke with our congregation to demonstrate the cities support for Ukraine. He spoke at at the ceremonial lighting of Hoan Bridge with the colors of the Ukrainian Flag, attended the Cinco De Mayo Festival where St Michael's was recognized for the heroic efforts and resiliency of the Ukrainian people in their fight for freedom. He met with Ukrainian Mayor Markushin when he visited Milwaukee and has maintained phone contact with him.

WE hosted a group of doctors from Ukraine who were visiting the Medical College of Wisconsin to learn how we manage our blood banks since blood is such a critical need in Ukraine during this war.

We have been involved in many TV and printed media interviews to educate and inform, update people of the situation in Ukraine.

Numerous churches, schools, businesses and other organizations have made donations or hosted fundraisers with us to support Ukraine.
