Dear City of Milwaukee Redevelopment Authority:


An application was recently submitted to the Historic Preservation Commission for the above temporary historic designation.

A public hearing has been scheduled for Monday, March 13, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. in City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Room 301-B to determine whether or not the proposed designation satisfies the criteria for temporary historic designation in accordance with Section 320-21 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
