
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Paul Kavanagh, a detective with the City of Milwaukee Police Department, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City vehicle that was traveling westbound on West Orchard Street. As the claimant's vehicle proceeded through the intersection of West Orchard Street and South 11<sup>th</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling northbound on South 11<sup>th</sup> Street at an excessive rate of speed, without his lights on, failed to yield and struck the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Detective Kavanagh sustained injuries to his neck, back, and right leg. Two surgeries were performed on the right leg and, as of today's date, Detective Kavanagh has not yet returned to work. The claimed medical expenses and loss wages total \$113,930.31.
