West Center Street

North 76th Street to North 92nd Street

Dear Honorable Members:

The Common Council has previously authorized and directed the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) for the programming and construction of street lighting on West Center Street from North 76th Street to North 92nd Street in conjunction with paving using Federal/State Aid under the Surface Transportation Program.

The construction will include the installation of new street light facilities and removing the existing street light poles and overhead facilities within the aforementioned project limit. Funding for the installation of the lighting would be available from WISDOT through an Agreed Unit Price contract.

The attached resolution authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an Agreed Upon Price contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install the lighting within the subject limits of West Center Street with Federal/State Aid under the Surface Transportation Program, which will cover 80 percent of the cost. The 20 percent local share will be funded through the City's Capital Improvement Program.
