REASON FOR REQUEST:

Zebdee Wilson, City of Milwaukee undercover police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating an unmarked City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling west on Villard Avenue. As the city vehicle entered the intersection of West Villard Avenue and North Sherman Boulevard, the uninsured motorist, who was proceeding south on North Sherman Boulevard, failed to yield the right-of-way by disregarding the red traffic signal, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Wilson sustained a concussion and injuries to his neck, right shoulder, and right ankle. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$25,322.36.
