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File # 021793 is an ordinance relating to employee benefits for non-represented, non-civilian, fire management employees.

Background

1. The City of Milwaukee has agreed to a number of wage and fringe benefit modifications for the non-represented, non-civilian, fire management employees covering the period of 2001-2003.
2. This ordinance will approve the changes in the wage and benefit structure for the for non-represented, non-civilian, fire management employees.

Discussion

1. This ordinance will modify the wage and fringe benefit structure for non-represented, non-civilian, fire management employees.
2. Base salary is increased 3.25% across-the-board for Pay Period 1 of 2001, 2002 and 2003.
3. Effective January 1, 2001 the monthly health insurance contribution toward coverage under the Basic Plan is increased from \$25 to \$60 for single coverage and from \$50 to \$120 for family coverage. Effective January 1, 2002 the single coverage premium is increased to \$100 and family coverage increased to \$190. Effective January 1, 2003, the single coverage premium is increased to \$136 and family coverage increased to \$249.22.
4. Effective Trimester 1, 2003, the sick leave control incentive payment is increased to \$200.
5. For 2002 and 2003, the uniform allowance is increased to \$300 and \$325, respectively.
6. Effective 2003, battalion chiefs and deputy chiefs will be eligible for a recall allowance of \$850.

Fiscal Impact

1. The increase in expenditure is a total of \$616,631 and is accounted for as follows:

- Salaries/Wages \$573,446
- Pension 35,353
- Life Insurance 3,707
- Other (Uniforms, Education) 4,125

2. A savings of \$52,581 is realized attributed to an increase in the employee premium for health insurance.
