#### PA-33E Narrative

This report is being submitted by Police Officer Robert GREGORY assigned to District 5-Late Shift.

On Monday, June 30th, 2014, I was assigned to Squad 5320. At 12:07AM, Squad 5392, Police Officer Steven HOLMBLAD, and I were dispatched to 2534 W. Hopkins St. for battery complaint. This is the address to the tavern, Warren's Lounge, The Milwaukee Fire Department was on scene and needed assistance restraining the victim.

Upon arrival I observed the victim, Marneeta M. MARTIN (B/F 07/12/1962), on the ground hysterically yelling and crying. MARTIN was being restrained by two MFD Firefighters. I then placed MARTIN in handcuffs so MFD could evaluate her. MARTIN stated that she was punched by a subject that she has never met before. MARTIN said the subject left when people told him the police were being called. MARTIN had visible swelling to the left side of her jaw and the right side of her forehead. PO HOLMBLAD then arrived on scene and spoke to witnesses regarding the incident.

Squad 5340, Police Officer Alfred HERRMANN and Police Officer John LARSON, responded to the scene as well. PO LARSON rode with the victim in Medicare 234 to St. Mary's Hospital. PO HERRMANN and I followed the ambulance while PO HOLMBLAD stayed on scene.

Once at St. Mary's Hospital, I interviewed MARTIN about the incident. MARTIN stated she was at the bar because her friend was bartending for the night. MARTIN was playing cards with some other friends in the bar when the suspect started talking with her female friend. MARTIN's female friend is married and her husband was at the bar. So, MARTIN told the suspect to stop it because her friends husband would get upset. The suspect then started to curse and call MARTIN names. MARTIN started yelling back at the suspect and then sat down on the other side of the bar.

At this time, MARTIN went to go buy her friend a drink. The suspect then came back and started cursing and calling her names again. MARTIN attempted to walk away and then the suspect punched her one time in the jaw. MARTIN then swung back at the suspect in an attempt to defend herself. The suspect then left when the police were going to be called.

MARTIN described the suspect as average height, heavy build, and light complected. MARTIN stated he had on a plaid shirt and blue jeans. MARTIN has never seen him before and did not know his name.

Squad 5311, Sergeant Steven JAECK, responded to St. Mary's Hospital and took photos of the injuries to MARTIN. SGT. JAECK took nine photos at 1:50AM.

PO HOLMBLAD then responded to St. Mary's Hospital to advise me on the information he gathered from the witnesses.

PO HOLMBLAD spoke to the bartender, Leoma STABLES (B/F 11/20/1953). STABLES stated MARTIN and the suspect were arguing earlier in the night and had to be broken up. STABLES believed MARTIN was the instigator in the argument because she was intoxicated. STABLES said MARTIN usually only drinks beer, but today was drinking gin. STABLES however did not see the suspect hit MARTIN. STABLES stated there are not any cameras inside of the tavern. STABLES knows the suspect as "Todd". STABLES states "Tod" is a regular to the bar. STABLES described the suspect as a B/M, 5'09", 270 pounds, light complected, and approximately 45 years of age. The suspect was wearing a plaid shirt and blue jeans.

PO HOLMBLAD then spoke with a witness. Sharon JOHNSON (B/F 04/19/1963) stated she saw MARTIN verbally harassing the suspect for most of the night. JOHNSON saw MARTIN get in the face of the suspect, pick up a bottle, and swing it at the suspect. MARTIN The suspect then grabbed MARTIN's arms so she could

not swing at him again. The suspect then punched MARTIN in the head with a closed fist. MARTIN then attempted to hit the suspect, and then fell to the ground.

I then went and asked MARTIN why witnesses would say she was the agitator in this incident and why she did not tell me that she swung a bottle at the suspect's head. MARTIN stated the suspect started the argument and that she swung the bottle at the suspect because he grabbed her by the throat first and she was defending herself. MARTIN stated she did not tell me that right away because she was still delirious from being hit.

MARTIN was treated by Doctor Stephanie BOYER. MARTIN was treated for swelling and bruising to her head. MARTIN did not sustain any broken bones.

I will return to Warren's Lounge to attempt to locate the suspect, "Todd".
