Mr. Aniban specified that HACM's engagement with Travaux is for Travaux to manage the project. Mr. Aniban stated, that these future townhome units will be Market Rate units, meaning that they are not funded by Capitol Fund grant dollars from HUD. These five buildings, consisting of 11 units, will be funded by the state's allotment of the American Rescue Plan Act through the City of Milwaukee, and a portion will be funded by non-federal sources. Jackie Martinez, HACM's Section 8 Program Director, summarized the Section 8 Utilization Update data provided with the agenda. Director McCarthy applauded how the information in the report is being presented. Ms. Martinez responded to Directors' questions regarding applicants suitability for a unit versus eligibility and leasing dips in the reporting metrics. Director McCarthy requested that for the next Board meeting information be provided on what the projections have been for Westlawn Renaissance lease up, and the impact thus far.

Greg Anderson, Travaux's Vice President of Asset Management, summarized the Occupancy and Work Order Reports for the Public, Affordable and Market Rate Housing provided with the agenda. Directors discussed developing a work order system to provide a trigger that will alert staff when a work order has exceeded 30, 60, and 90 days.
