Subject: Scenarios for Revising Milwaukee Taxicab Meter Rates to Equal 20-City Average

for 8-Mile Trip Charge

You had requested information relating to scenarios for revising Milwaukee taxicab meter rates to equal the 8-mile trip charge for a 20-city average of cities that are comparable in population size to Milwaukee. Provided in the table below are 3 rate-change scenarios (A, B and C) which include the following rate change proposals:

- Scenario A (\$19.34): Increases the initial "flag drop" charge from \$2.25 to \$2.75 and reduces the additional charge per current fraction of mile from \$0.25 to \$0.21.
- Scenario B (\$19.63): Makes no change to the initial "flag drop" charge, but reduces the additional charge per current fraction of mile from \$0.25 to \$0.22.
- Scenario C (\$19.29): Makes no change to the initial "flag drop" charge, but changes the fraction of a mile increment from the current 1/10th of a mile to 1/9th of a mile and reduces the additional charge per fraction of mile from \$0.25 to \$0.24.
