The male officer, Police Officer Stephen CHIN, 62640, District #1 - early, was interviewed. Officer CHIN believed that #5\_ grabbed #20 by the belt during the search.

Detectives interviewed #3 who confirmed that she conducted the search. #5 stated that #20 was wearing very tight jeans and that she had to pull on each pocket in order to complete the search. #5

#### **CONCLUSION:**

Investigation by the CIU revealed that \$120 was stopped by Officer CHIN for a traffic violation. During the stop #s who was off duty, conducted a search of #20 stated that #5 #5 · # 20 井てい #5 -stated that she did not grab ento # 2 . -but merely pulled on each pocket to conduct the search. The CIU investigation can not show that intent was to do anything else than conduct a search. Since we #5 can not show a criminal intent this case does not amount to a 4th Degree Sexual Assault. This case will be cleared as baseless.
