Existing stone wall at S. 7th Street and at 10LF along W. Lincoln Avenue (constructed 2019).



Existing stone wall at NW corner of S. 7th Street and W. Lincoln Ave. abutting existing concrete retaining wall to the east to be clad in stone, approximately, 89LF east along W. Lincoln Avenue.



Existing N concrete retaining wall at along W. Lincoln Ave. to be clad in stone full height (approx. 86LF x 5FT tall) with stone cap.
