This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/21/2018 officers were dispatched to a battery at Lucky Sam Food Mart, 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup> St. The applicant was the caller and stated a subject was in the store causing a disturbance and breaking things. The subject was located and issued citations for Disorderly Conduct and Vandalism.

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2. On 10/17/2019 officers were dispatched to Mark Food Mart, 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup> St, for a Property Damage. The investigation revealed a female patron was upset with a recent transaction. The female began knocking over displays causing a disturbance. The female was not on scene and could not be located.
3. On 03/20/2020 officers, along with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at Lucky Sam Food Mart, 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup>. There were two employees on scene when officers arrived. Neither employee had a Class D Operator's license and the business is licensed to sell alcohol. The officers found an open package of cigarettes behind the counter. The clerk initially denied selling single cigarettes but did admit selling singles for \$0.50. The officers also located items for sale that are used as drug paraphernalia. The applicant arrived at the location and was asked about the drug paraphernalia. He apologized for selling the items. The applicant did not have any invoices for the tobacco at the location. He admitted to buying it from someone in Illinois for under wholesale cost. The officers located beer stored in the basement, which is not listed on the

liquor license. The applicant was advised to move the beer to the licensed area of the business or add the basement as a storage location. The applicant was advised of complaints of people loitering in front of his store selling drugs. The applicant stated he does not call the police, he just asks the subjects to leave on his own.

4. On 03/23/2020 at 12:19pm officers responded to Lucky Sam's, 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup> St. for a Drug Dealing complaint. There were multiple subjects outside when police arrived, but they immediately walked off. The officers spoke with the applicant, who stated he does not know why the officers are getting called and would contact police if he saw anything. He advised the officers they were welcome to view the cameras at any time.
5. On 03/24/2020 at 1:20pm officers, along with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at Lucky Sam Food Mart, 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup>. The Wisconsin Department of Revenue agent advised the applicant that due to him not cooperating with the investigation regarding the subject from Illinois that he purchased the tobacco from, she was confiscating all the untaxed tobacco from the store. The subject was issued the Responsible Person on Premise citation from item #2.
6. On 03/29/2020 at 5:36pm officers were dispatched to a shooting at 2513 N. 21<sup>st</sup> St. During the investigation officers went to Lucky Sam Food Mart, 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup> St to check for video surveillance. The officers were able to view the video which did capture the incident.
7. On Monday, May 26, 2020, at approximately 11:36 PM, officers were dispatched STOIBER, was dispatched to a shooting, located at 2409 N 21st St. Upon arrival they observed a black male laying on his side against fence at 2409 N 21st St. This scene was located approximately six feet north of Lucky Sam Food Mart located at 2401 N 21st St, a premise licensed for the sale of tobacco, Class A fermented malt beverages, and food. This business was closed at the time of the shooting.

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8. On 07/14/20 officers and a Police Captain held a meeting with the agent and his attorney for 2401. 21<sup>st</sup> (Lucky Sam Food Mart). The agent advised he would add additional cameras and adjust the view point of cameras to maximize coverage for loitering and drug dealing. The agent further stated he would also contact police on a weekly basis regarding loitering on a weekly basis. The agent stated he would provide officers with a detailed abatement plan within a couple of weeks to assist with abating the issues the business faces.
9. On 07/27/20 officers and a Police Captain conducted an onsite meeting at 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup> (Lucky Sam Food Mart). The agent had added 3 additional cameras to the outside of the business, an identification reader for the cashier, and posted a no loitering sign outside. The agent further advised officers he trained his employee on recovering video surveillance. The agent was cooperative and agreed to attend crime and safety meetings as well as sign up for E-Notify.

10. On 09/23/20 officers conducted follow up at 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup> St. (Lucky Sam Food Mart) for business updates. Officers observed 2 business signs with the address and phone number had been posted outside of the building. Six exterior cameras with night vision had been installed and police were provided with the camera passcode. The ID card reader was active behind the counter. The agent advised officers he did not have any issues since the upgrades were installed and had been attending neighborhood meetings.
  
11. On 11/10/20 at 1:18pm, officers along with Department of Revenue Agents conducted a License Premise check at 2401 N. 21<sup>st</sup> St (Lucky Sam Food Mart). The license for the business only permitted first floor access, however, liquor was found neatly stacked in the basement. The agent was on scene and cooperative and stated he would add the basement to the license.

On Tuesday, July 14, 2020 at approximately 1pm, Captain Norman held a meeting with the owner of Lucky Sam's inside District Three's conference room. The listed people were in attendance.

1. ADA, Kelly O'Neill
2. Alcohol and Tobacco Agent, Georgeann King
3. Owner of Lucky Sam's, Sukhdev Singh
4. Attorney Vincent Bobot
5. Attorney Michael Maistelman

During the meeting, the following was discussed:

Singh and his Attorneys stated the business has approximately 20 cameras installed with 15 inside and about 5 outside. Singh stated they would add additional cameras if needed and willing to adjust the viewpoint of the outside cameras in order to maximize the coverage for loitering and drug dealing. Singh stated the business will provide officers with not only calling the Police when activities are happening but also noting the people loitering and vehicles on a weekly base. Singh stated he has stopped selling drug paraphernalia inside his store after Georgeann King and the Community Prosecution Office conducted a site visit. Singh stated he also went and added his father Ranjit to the bartenders license after he received a citation from our office. Singh stated he did not call the police on multiple occasions because he knew officers was busy so he just asked the people to move. Singh ended by saying he is willing to do whatever it take to continue his business.

Singh's Attorney's stated they would provide our office with a detailed abatement plan within the next couple weeks. The plan will outline everything they will put into place to assist with abating the issues the business faces.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 6/22/2021 at 11:50 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or [molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov](mailto:molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov) for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
