HS ALERT SWAT Armored Vehicle 2018

Grant Type: New Grant

Grantor: Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) Homeland Security

Grant Period: October 15, 2018—November 29, 2019

Award Amount: \$225,000

Match Required: No match is required. However, the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) will fund any additional cost over \$225,000 that is necessary to complete the purchase.

Fiscal Agent: Milwaukee Police Department (MPD)

Allocation Purpose: Funding may be used for equipment. All expenses must be new and cannot replace existing state or local government funding.

Partners: N/A

Research & Evaluation: Program reports must be submitted quarterly. Financial reports frequency must be submitted quarterly. Equipment grants will require an inventory report in addition to program and financial reports.

Program Goals

The Armored Tactical Response Vehicle will be strategically positioned in the Milwaukee metropolitan area to allow a team capable of extraction and rescue in hostile situations within minutes of activation. This vehicle can also be utilized by the Tactical Enforcement Unit in support of smaller, less equipped, agencies or any other agency which requests MPD assistance in dealing with any such incident or event.

Programmatic Summary

WEM will provide grant funds for an armored vehicle that will increase the City of Milwaukee Police Department's ability to provide a tactical response in their area of responsibility for Aligned Law Enforcement Response Team (ALERT). More specifically, this grant will support the Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team by funding an Armored Tactical Response Vehicle to enhance the capabilities and safe responses for regional SWAT teams in their ALERT initiatives as the armored vehicle allows for better protection and safety of personnel during a tactical response.
