At a public hearing held on Monday, October 14, 2013, the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC), by a vote of four (4) ayes, zero (0) noes, and three (3) excused, granted a Certificate of Appropriateness to remove an existing rear addition and replace it with a new sunroom at 2951 N. Lake Drive, in accordance with the provisions of Section 320-21-11 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
