
This is to notify you that on Wednesday, February 18, 2026, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council not to renew your Class A Fermented Malt license and to renew with a 90 (ninety) day suspension your Food Dealer license based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and resident and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations and gambling; for the premises located at 418 E CENTER ST. ("TITTU REHMAT FOOD").

On February 20, 2026, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class A Fermented Malt and Food Dealer licenses, in which the Committee recommended nonrenewal of your Class A Fermented Malt and renewal with a 90 (ninety) day suspension of your Food Dealer license based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and resident and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations and gambling. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting on Tuesday, March 3, 2026 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. On that date, time, and place, you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee, but we received communication from your counsel requesting to speak before the Common Council.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to return your Class A Fermented Malt and Food Dealer licenses applications to Committee for further consideration.

You will receive a new hearing notice in the mail.
