Resolution approving Amendment No. 2 to the Project Plan for Tax Incremental District No. 94 1st and Becher and authorizing additional expenditures, and approving a development agreement, in the 4th Aldermanic District. The resolution will allow the City to enter into a development agreement with Milwaukee Board of School Directors dba Milwaukee Public Schools to facilitate the construction of a Riverwalk adjacent to the newly rehabilitated Lincoln Playfields, at 300 W Lincoln Avenue. The agreement will allow the City to adhere to the Riverwalk funding policy by providing up to \$475,000 toward the cost to construct a public Riverwalk.

Identify the anticipated equity impacts, if any, of this proposal.

This project will provide an accessible public access connection to the Kinnickinnic River and the Riverwalk System. The shores of the Milwaukee, Menomonee and Kinnickinnic Rivers are not reserved for those who can afford to live or work on them, but are free and open to all through projects such as this.

All minority groups, of all levels of ability, will be positively impacted through the created opportunity to enjoy the benefits of a publicly accessible Riverwalk. They can access the Milwaukee Riverwalk System and have access to the commercial and recreational activities directly adjacent.

The approval of the financing for this project includes public hearings at the Joint Review Board, Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee and the Zoning Neighborhood and Development Committee of the Common Council.
