There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

Officers attempted to enter the bar and found the front door locked. After knocking several times, a subject unlocked the door and allowed police in. Police observed alcoholic beverages in front of three patrons. Police also observed the owner Louise Burdue and two bartenders, Jason Peterson and Bethany Chamberlain, also in the bar. Burdue stated to police that she was yelling for the last 20 minutes to her bartenders to get the patrons out of the tavern. Burdue also stated she as well told patrons to leave. 3. On 03/04/11 at 10:05 pm, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check at 100 W Maple. As police entered they observed two females smoking a cigarettes while in the tavern. The subjects were identified as Louise Burdue, owner of the bar, and the bartender, identified as Gale Benn. Burdue stated that she thinks the no smoking ban is a joke and that she will smoke in her bar if she wants to. She was advised to follow all laws and both received citations. Neither citation could be located in the municipal court system.

Incident # 3 citation for smoking was found in the municipal system. The applicant was found guilty and fined \$100.00 for the violation. (12011897)

4. On 11/18/2014 Milwaukee police responded to an armed robbery complaint at 100 West Maple Street (Ollie's Bar). Investigation revealed the business, and its patrons, was robbed at gunpoint. Milwaukee police incident report #143220001 filed.

- 10. On 02/14/2019 officers, along with agents from the WI Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at Ollie's, 100 W. Maple St. The officers found three bottles of alcohol contaminated with fruit flies. The applicant disposed of the alcohol and was advised to have business record at the tavern and not at her residence.
- 11. On 12/02/2019 officer, along with agents from the WI Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at Ollie's, 100 W. Maple St. based upon a complaint the business license was expired. The officer checked LIRA and found the license expired on 11/30/2019 and a renewal had not been filed yet. The officer arrived and found the business open with a patron drinking beer. The bartender called the applicant who came down from her residence upstairs. The applicant was unable to speak because of a medical condition and could not explain why the license expired. The applicant's daughter arrived and stated she thought the license expired on 12/30/2019 and expressed interest in becoming the agent of the business.

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Early Power Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On Thursday, February 14, 2019, at 5:11 PM, Squad 2464 (P.O. Oscar ESPITIA) and 2268 (P.O. VODICKA) assisted Agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue with an inspection of Oilie's, located at 100 W Maple St.

The licensee, Louise BURDUE, was present and cooperative for the inspection. BURDUE'S daughter, Melissa BURDUE (F/W 12/18/84), was tending bar. Melissa BURDUE does not hold a bartending license; however, she resides with her mother so a license is not required. The inspection revealed that the alcohol and fermented malt beverages were purchased from licensed distributors and no alcohol was seized. I did observe 3 bottles of alcohol that were contaminated by fruit flies and BURDUE promptly disposed of the contents.

BURDUE was advised to keep her business records, including alcohol invoices, on premises instead of in her residence which is not a portion of the licensed premises and to deface empty bottles prior to recycling them.

#### **Licensed Premises Report**

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two Day Shift, Community Prosecution Unit. On Monday, December 2, 2019, at or about 1:35 PM, Squad 2166 (P.O. Matthew DIENER and I) along with A.C.A. Heather HOUGH and Dept of Revenue Special Agent Georgeann KING, did conduct a licensed premises check at Ollie's, located at 100 W Maple St, after having received a complaint from another police officer that the tavern was operating without a license. A check of L.I.R.A. revealed that the license for the tavern had expired on 11/30/19 and that the licensee had not applied for a renewal of the license and that a provisional license had not been applied for or granted.

Upon approaching the tavern I observed a 3' sign on the sidewalk which read, "YES WE ARE OPEN". Upon entering the business officers observed the lights to be on, a bartender (later identified as Michael T KEMPA (M/W 01/29/60) working behind the bar, and one patron seated at the bar drinking a beer. Officers explained the nature of the visit, observed that the expired license was posted behind the bar, and requested that KEMPA notify the the licensee, who resides above the tavern, that officers needed to speak with her.

The licensee, Louise A BURDUE, descended the staircase from her residence but was unable to speak with officers due to health conditions. BURDUE was able to communicate by mouthing words and by writing them. BURDUE was unable to explain why the license had not been renewed or why the business was operating without a license beyond her medical issues. BURDUE'S daughter, Melissa BURDUE later arrived on scene and stated that she believed the license did not expire until 12/30/19 and she stated that she was interested in becoming the agent for the tavern. I did explain that the licensee would likely be cited and I also explained the processes for applying for a new license and a provisional license.

Agent KING conducted an inspection and provided the attached field inspection form.

If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
